## ❖ Quiz Competition, March 24



The objective behind organising this programme was to make the student understand their duties, rights, and their right conduct as student.






**Dr. Munmun Banerjee**, Assistant Professor, Department of Education, Sapatgram College was invited to deliver the lecture.

# ❖ Online Special Lecture Programme, May 8





On 8/05/2021, a special online lecture programme was organised on the theme

## ❖ Virtual lecture programme, May 20



# ❖ Orientation programme for student, June 4




## ❖ Virtual Awareness Programme , June 18






# ❖ Youth Colloquium, June 22









Second and third prize winners of Quiz competition organised by Bilaspada Election District


