

## Report on

Memorandum of Understanding between Silghaghari Village, Kadamtala GP Report near Sapatgram and Department of Education, Sapatgram college,

**Dated-08.12.2022**

**Report of MoU:** -Silghaghari village is a small size village located in Bilasipara Circle of Dhubri district, Assam with total 70 families residing. The Silghaghari village has population of 600 (six hundred) of which 236 are males while 374 are females as per the view of the Gaobura of the village. Total voters of this village are almost 400. The village is 68 km. from the district head quarter and 30 km. away from high way. In Silghaghari village population of children with age 0-6 is 30 which makes up 5 % of total population of village. After a thorough observation it is found that maximum people of this village are very poor. There are very less number of govt. service holders. Carpenters, daily labourers, small business man and farmers are found in this village. Maximum people are deprived from govt well-fare schemes and facilities. Females/ house wives are unaware about the various govt schemes. It is also found that people are very much traditional, believes in superstitions, illiterate/ uneducated etc. The village is very less developed and therefore many people migrated from this area. Maximum people of the village are not avail higher education.

MoU signed by the gaobura Mr. Ashok Roy of the village in front of the village people and by the HoD of the Department of Education, Dr. Munmun Banerjee. Sapatgram College. Witnessed by Mr. Chakraborty, a senior citizen by of the village and Mrs. Mithu Biswas, SMC member of the village. It is also signed by Head master of Santipur ME School, Mr. Vivash Bhowmick and HoD of the Department of Education.



### Objectives of the MoU:

1. The main purpose of MoU with the village is to develop the village socio-educationally.
2. To organize some community service program for the well fare of the people of Silghagri village.

3. To organize some awareness program for women empowerment and their upliftment. Also organize campaign on health, education like Beti Bachao, Beti Porao etc., Gender Equality, Environmental awareness etc. time to time.
4. The department will organize some co-curricular and extra - curricular activities for the personality development of the students of Shilghagri village studying in Lilannda Vidyapith ME School(Santipur).
5. Another objective of the MoU is to organize some outreach program with the involvement of the students of the department of education in the village and in the school as well.

Mr. Sankar Mandal an outsource worker of Sapatgram APDCL office and off course the village representative is appointed as the coordinator of the signed MoU with Department of education and Silghagri Village. The Department will help the village from every corner up to their capacity.
